## Entering and joining the event

**Enter** in MyABF as for other events. You **do not** need to download an App or Programme. During the day of the event you will **receive an email with the link** to use to join it. Check your Junk mail if you do not get the email.

Please join the event 30-15 minutes before it starts.

## BAWA and ABF Regulations

BAWA Supplementary Regulations on the BAWA website and the online conditions in the ABF Laws and Regulations apply.

In Brief, the ABF online conditions primarily refer to **Misclicks and Undos**:

- Law 25A i) A change of call will be permitted via “Undo” for a misclick where the Director is satisfied that the original call made was unintended
- Law 45C4b i) a change of a played card will be permitted via “Undo” for a misclick where the Director is satisfied that the original card played was unintended.
